## Scaddan Coal Project Scoping Study For Export Options

### Client

Blackham Resources Ltd

### Project Location

Approximately 60 km's north of the town and port of Esperance, and 10 km's east of the Esperance to Kalgoorlie highway, gas pipeline and railway line.

### Project Summary

The Scaddan Coal Project is a joint venture between Blackham Resources (via its subsidiary Scaddan Energy) and Wesfarmers Resources who have a 70% and 30% contributing interest respectively.

Engenium was asked to complete a Scoping Study on the Scaddan Coal Project, a Lignite deposit located 60 km's north of Esperance in Western Australia, to identify and review the export options of Scaddan Coal through the Esperance Port.

The Study evaluated several options for development including:

- 8 Mtpa production via an expanded bulk Port of Esperance with Blackham paying its additional port capital requirements.
- 8 Mtpa production via an expanded bulk Port of Esperance with an infrastructure group paying additional port capital requirements. Blackham would pay an additional tariff to access the third party infrastructure.

The Scoping Study report documented the logistics options identified and provided ranked recommendations for consideration in the Pre-Feasibility Study.

The Scaddan Energy Project contains total JORC resource of 860 million tonnes of lignite and the venture partners have a combined landholding in the Scaddan region in excess of 120,000 hectares.
