A 10 year mine life was valued at \$79 million for 0.5 Mtpa and \$241 million for 1.0 Mtpa. A 20 year mine life was valued at \$148 million for 0.5 Mtpa and \$376 million for 1.0 Mtpa.

Project Summary

Montezuma Mining Company (Montezuma) wish to establish a commercially viable Manganese mining operation just 120 kms south of Newman, located in the Pilbara region of Western Australia.

Engenium was engaged to provide an initial Report to assist Montezuma in the decision to develop the Butcherbird Project, which is 100% owned by Montezuma.

The Scoping Study investigated the development of a mine producing between 0.5 Mtpa and 1 Mtpa of lump and chip ore grading a nominal 36% Mn with a mine life of at least 10 years.

The Report included an assessment of mineral resource and metallurgy, mining and processing, logistics and port, infrastructure and utilities and Estimates and Financial Analysis.
